## Brief details regarding airfare structures

There are different airfares in both Economy and Business classes and availability of the lower airfares depends on a number of factors. One of these being surcharges for shoulder and peak seasons. Apart from the seasonal surcharges the lowest airfare for Air Seychelles Economy class is G and the lowest airfare for Business class is D – the highest being Y and J respectively. The airfares alter between the seasons but for all seasons the airfares increase in price as the availability of seats on particular flights lessens in both Economy & Business class. This is termed “yield management” by the airlines and is why occasionally there will be a quickfire sale or special offer on certain flights where business is not as brisk as the airline would like.

### General Time Info:

- The flight time is approx. 5 hours
- Slight variations in arrival and departure times may occur.
- Seychelles is 2 hours ahead of South African time.

### Luggage Allowance:

- Air Seychelles strictly adheres to the luggage allowance per person age 2 years and over of 2 pieces per person of 23 kgs each for Economy and 2 pieces of 32 kgs for Business per person..
- Additional sport equipment baggage allowance up to a maximum of 10 kgs may be applied for but if the cargo hold is fully booked Air Seychelles reserves the right to withdraw this. It should also be noted that any additional complimentary luggage allowance is not covered by Air Seychelles in terms of loss, damage or mishandling.
- Hand luggage is limited to 7 kgs in one bag.

## Baggage Information

Air Seychelles is committed to providing a baggage service to satisfy the requirements of today's busy traveller.

This section aims to provide you with instant baggage information so as to avoid any misunderstandings when travelling with Air Seychelles. Everything you need to know is here, from hand luggage to excess baggage rates, check-in baggage to restricted items, etc. Of particular note is that any piece of baggage MUST NOT weigh more than 32KG.

## Hand Luggage

Air Seychelles hand luggage allowances are as follows:

International Business Class	International Economy Class	Connecting	Domestic non-connecting
10 kgs	7 kgs	7 kgs	5 kgs

- One piece of hand luggage with maximum dimensions 55cm x 40cm x 20cm (115cms) not exceeding 7kgs in weight may be carried free of charge. These dimensions include wheels handles and side pockets. Any items you may wish to take into the cabin of the aircraft must be able to fit under the seat (e.g. a briefcase or flight bag).
- Adults accompanying infants are entitled to check in one infant item in addition to the adult's baggage allowance. Infant items can include collapsible push-chair, collapsible cot/bassinet, car seat or carrying basket. Please request for approval upon check-in.

If you require a bassinet onboard, you must notify Air Seychelles at the time of reservation. Bassinets may be requested for infants up to 6 months of age and not weighing more than 11kg / 25 lbs. Bassinets are subject to availability.

- Any extra KGs is 7 USD (\$) per kilo

When passing through security at the airport please remove from your cabin baggage for individual inspection:

- All large electrical items, e.g. laptops, large digital cameras and DVD players.
- The clear plastic bag containing your bottles and tubes.
- Medication accompanied by a prescription or relevant medical certificate.
- Baby food in liquid form.

## Check-In Baggage

Air Seychelles' checked baggage allowances are as follows:

- The maximum weight per individual piece of checked baggage must not exceed 32 kgs in cases where the passenger has purchased extra kilos.
- Other Airlines (non-HM / Non-HM Codeshare) allowances 20KG on Domestic Flights.
- Any single piece of baggage weighing more than 32 kgs will not be accepted

at check-in and passengers will be required to reduce the weight by re-packing the baggage or sending it by cargo.

- Overall excess baggage weight will be subject to additional fees, payable at the airport before departure. [View excess baggage rates](#) or contact your nearest Air Seychelles Sales Office.
- It is essential that you label each piece of your baggage – both inside and outside- with your name (and preferably with your address too). Labels are available on request. To ensure your baggage does not open accidentally please lock it securely.

## Security Warnings to Passengers

In the interest of your own security, your attention is directed to the following points-

Please ensure that you can personally confirm the safety of all the contents of the bags you are checking in.

- If you have been given a present or other article by anyone with the request that you take it with you on your flight, you should inform an airline representative, Police, or customs official immediately.
- Do not accept any such presents or articles from anyone AFTER checking-in for your flight.
- Do not leave your baggage at any time unobserved.
- Please note that hold or checked luggage may be subject to examination by X-ray equipment.

## Sports Equipment

Sport equipment accepted as part of normal luggage allowance:

### Fishing

Rods and reels contained in a case and one bag with fishing tackle, landing net, and fishing boots.

### Cycling

Non motorized bicycle - Handlebars fixed sideways and pedals removed. Pedals and handlebars encased in plastic. Tyres deflated. Enclosed in cardboard

### Diving

Scuba tank, scuba regulator, tank harness, and tank pressure gauge (subject to max weight). 15Kg of Scuba equipment

### Golf

Bag containing clubs, balls, umbrella & golf shoes. 15Kg Complimentary on a set of clubs

### Surfboard

Surfboards must be packed in suitable surfboard bags. At check -in, to be tagged with a limited release tag and passenger must sign for it meaning that HM is not liable for any damage.

As per table below, at Air Seychelles discretion, additional sporting equipment may be accepted.

- Any additional weight will be charged for at the [excess baggage rates](#).
- The maximum weight of your sports equipment should not weigh more than 32Kg.
- Handling staff is allowed to perform checks of contents of sporting equipment.
- All equipment must not exceed maximum dimensions of 62" or 158cm
- Any additional baggage allowed by Air Seychelles at no additional fee will be transported at the passengers' own risk and cannot be claimed for in the

event of loss or damage.

## Restricted Items

For safety reasons, dangerous articles such as those listed below, must not be carried in passengers baggage:

Dangerous Items:

- Compressed gases (Deeply refrigerated, flammable, non-flammable and poisonous) such as butane, oxygen, liquid nitrogen and aqualung cylinders.
- Corrosives such as acids, alkalis, mercury and wet-cell batteries.
- Explosives, munitions, fireworks and flares.
- Flammable liquids and solids such as lighter fuel, matches, paints, thinners and fire-lighters.
- Radioactive materials.
- Brief-cases and attaché cases with installed alarm devices.
- Oxidising materials such as bleaching powder and peroxides.
- Poisons and infectious substances such as insecticides, weed-killers and live virus materials

## Customs Formalities

The duty free allowance for all liquors (including wine, beer, stout, ale and port) perfumes and tobacco is:

200 cigarettes or 250g of tobacco  
2 litres of spirits and 2 litres of wine  
200ml of Perfume or Eau de Toilette

All personal possessions intended to be re-exported on departure are exempt from tax. In addition to the duty free allowances listed above, each visitor may import tax-free a video camera, other camera, musical instrument, portable electronic or electric equipment, sports requisites and other leisure equipment.

Offensive weapons such as stun guns, mace, bows and arrows, knuckle dusters, daggers, swords, tear gas, whips, firearms and ammunition are prohibited imports unless the appropriate import permit or official authorization has been obtained in advance from the relevant authorities.

This also applies to spear guns, fireworks, pyrotechnic products and explosives of any kind.

The import of plants and parts of plants, animals and animal products, biological specimens, radioactive substances and apparatus, dangerous drugs, chemicals, medicines, pharmaceutical items and poisons is forbidden without the necessary import permit or official authorization having been obtained in advance from the relevant authorities.

The value of food items brought into Seychelles by a passenger must not be in excess of the SCR3,000 personal/household allowance unless the relevant import permits have been obtained in advance.

Pornography in the form of obscene articles, publications, video tapes and software is strictly forbidden.

Where goods are imported in excess of allowances, payment of import tax is to be made in cash (or personal cheque drawn on a local account). Credit card facilities are not available for the payment of import tax.
